Foundation to Year 2 Overall Expectations – Linking to ‘Everything is Music: Bicycles and Boats’

Music is the study and exploration of sound and the expressive use of musical elements through the instruments. Students will join together in musical activities, using instruments to develop concepts about sound, musical awareness and appreciation of music in all its forms from a range of times, places and cultures. Students will have the opportunity to experiment with sounds making expressive use of musical elements such as beat, pitch and rhythm.

They will participate both individually and in groups in games and creative movement activities. They will develop an awareness and appreciation of music from different cultures and be able to describe and compare sounds using simple appropriate musical vocabulary.

Children will have the opportunity to identify and reflect upon “big ideas” by making connections between the questions asked and the concepts that drive the inquiry. They will become aware of the relevance these concepts have to all of their learning.
